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DRCOG HOLDS PUBLIC HEARING APRIL 16 Regional plan amendments focus of hearing

April 2, 2014 (Denver, Colorado) – The Denver Regional Council of Governments (DRCOG) Board of Directors will hold a public hearing at 6:30 p.m. Wednesday, April 16, 2014, at 1290 Broadway, Denver. The hearing is an opportunity to comment on proposed amendments to the [Metro Vision 2035 Plan](#), [2035 Metro Vision Regional Transportation Plan \(2035 MVRTP\)](#), the DRCOG CO and PM10 Conformity Determination, and the Denver Southern Subarea 8-hour Ozone Conformity Determination. The Board is scheduled to act on the proposed amendments at the same meeting.

Several amendments are proposed to the *Fiscally Constrained 2035 Regional Transportation Plan (FC-2035 RTP)* of the *2035 Metro Vision Regional Transportation Plan (2035 MVRTP)*. The proposed amendments address CDOT Responsible Acceleration of Maintenance and Partnerships (RAMP) funded projects, RTD FasTracks changes to the North Metro Rail Line and I-225 Rail Line, and local government projects.
